

Every time I fly, I listen to the music of J.S. Bach and Arvo Pärt. It helps me to get into the state of flow, to break through the thoughts and stressful problems, which are overwhelming my brain, and just enjoy the time tête-àtête with the music. Slowly, this music started to sound in my head, but on the strings of my instrument. To create this album was just a matter of time.

In Credo the crystalline voice of the harp bridges two worlds — baroque and minimalistic, rational and mystical, sacred and personal. Across 250 years, Johann Sebastian Bach and Arvo Pärt emerge as two exceptional composers, each guided by profound structural thinking, a mathematical understanding of melodic and harmonic lines, and a transcendent relationship with silence and sound. Their music, rooted in voice, shaped by architecture, and refined through faith, reveals a timeless unity.


Alexander Boldachev brings their works together through a single instrument: the harp. Often misunderstood, underestimated, or confined to stereotypes, the harp here ascends to its rightful place among the great instruments of humanity. Through eight groundbreaking arrangements, Boldachev unveils the instrument's full expressive and technical capacity—

its power, its fragility, its breath and resonance.

This album is not just a collection of meditative and virtuoso compositions - it's a sanctuary. A relief for overloaded minds. A soundtrack for meditation, focused work, mindful walking, flying across continents, or simply sitting still in nature. It is music that uplifts, without overwhelming. A powerful message delivered with grace and clarity of the most antique and modern instrument in the world.

The album was recorded in the secluded Aiglon College Chapel in Villars-sur-Ollon, Switzerland—a haven of silence and reflection, nestled high in the mountains. Far from the noise of the world, this space allowed the music to breathe and the soul to speak. A place where science, divinity, and music converge.


He was also crucified for us, suffered under Pontius Pilate, and was buried.
