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In these live recordings from Joseph Meyerhoff Symphony Hall in Baltimore, Dyořák's most darkly dramatic and passionate symphony, the Seventh, is coupled with his Eighth, notable for its dramatic contrasts. Bohemian lyricism, and a seemingly spontaneous flow of thematic ideas.
